M1 J23A–J24 CLOSURE

**FRIDAY 11TH (2200H SOUTHBOUND & MIDNIGHT NORTHBOUND) TO SUNDAY 13TH MAY (1500H)
J23A–J24 OF THE M1 WILL BE CLOSED TO ALL TRAFFIC**

This is to enable two separate projects of work to happen.

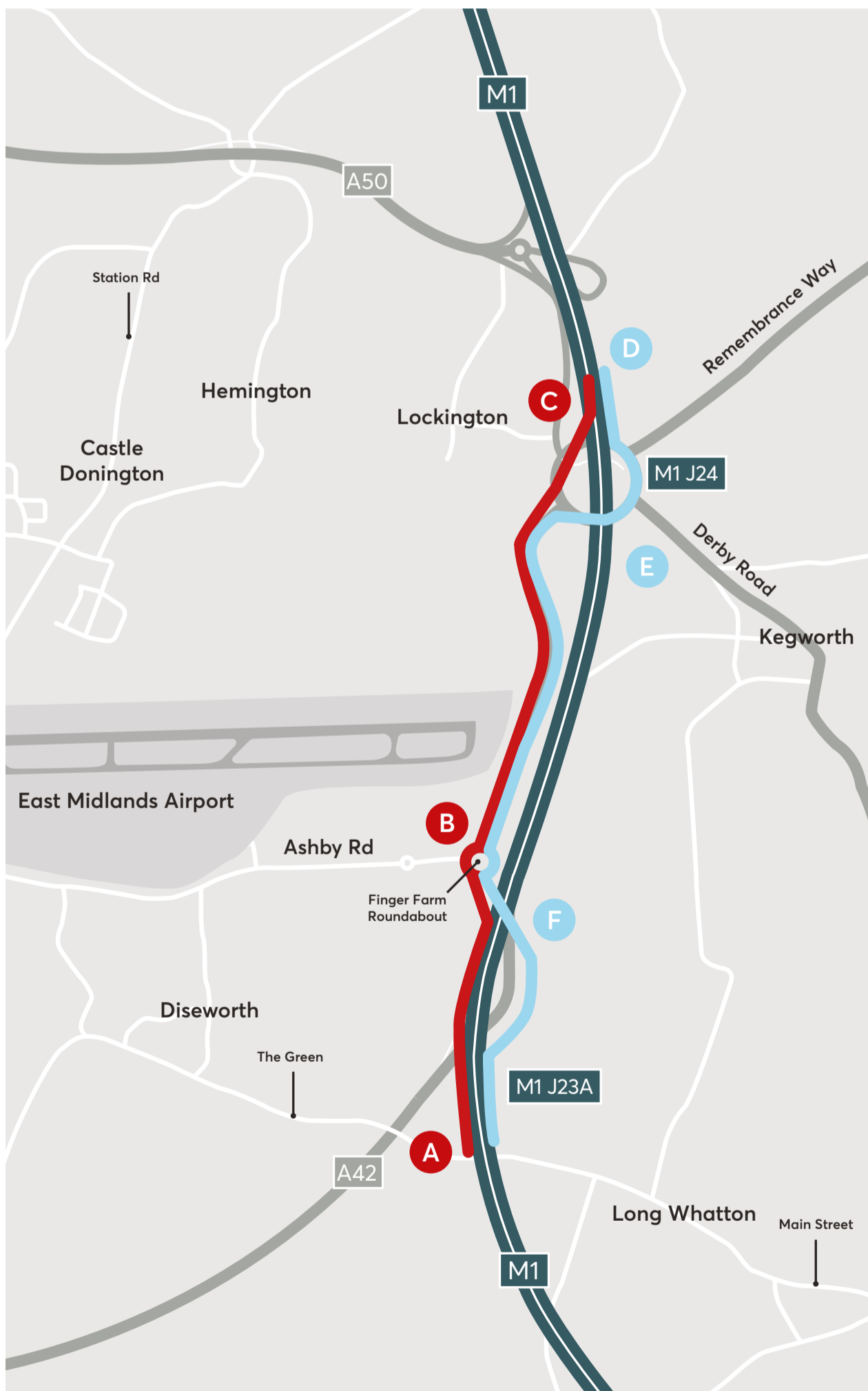
The Kegworth Bypass bridge will be launched over the motorway, south of Ashby Road Bridge, as part of a major infrastructure construction development at SEGRO Logistics Park East Midlands Gateway.

Separately - and in order to avoid another full closure of the motorway - Highways England will be taking the opportunity to carry out essential bridge waterproofing works south of J23A.

There will be a traffic diversion route along the A453 for the entire time.

As the M1 is one of the UK's busiest motorways, we expect significant congestion and delays along this diversion route and the Motorway. Therefore we advise drivers avoid this area if possible and allow for extra time for their journey – in particular if travelling to East Midlands Airport.

KEY

M1 Northbound Diversion

- A** Exit the M1 at Junction 23A and continue on the A42 until you reach Finger Farm Roundabout
- B** Take the third exit onto Ashby Road (A453)
- C** When you approach J24, take the second exit which will lead you back onto the M1 North

M1 Southbound Diversion

- D** Exit the M1 at Junction 24
- E** When you approach motorway roundabout, take the fourth exit onto Ashby Road (A453)
- F** Continue until you reach Finger Farm Roundabout and take the first exit which will lead you back onto the M1 South
